

ELMBROOK UNITED RAINOUT CANCELLATION POLICY

Regardless of what games are scheduled, Elmbrook United may cancel the entire day's home game schedule if the weather has created field drainage problems during the week, or if rain is predicted for the day. Severe weather or snow may also cause a total club cancellation of home games.

PLEASE check the Elmbrook United website for game cancellations. Game cancellations will be posted by 3:00 pm during the week and 8:00 am on weekends.

If an entire day's schedule of recreational games is canceled, these games will be rescheduled on the designated fall rain date – **Sunday, May 18**. If another entire day's schedule of recreational games is canceled, we will make every effort to reschedule these games on another Sunday or weeknight.

Individual recreational games also may be canceled due to sudden severe weather, rain, or lightning. If unexpected severe weather arises, your referee may stop your game or EBU may sound an air horn to stop all games at Voigt Soccer Park. If you hear the air horn, or if your referee stops your game, leave the field immediately, quickly proceed to your car, and exit the park. Consider your game canceled.

If your game was stopped during the first half, the game will be rescheduled. If it was stopped any time after the start of the second half (even if only a minute has been played) it is considered a full game and the score at that time will stand.

<u>Practices</u>: Practices are canceled at the discretion of each individual coach. Occasionally, the City of Brookfield may ask EBU to cancel practices due to poor field conditions. If the city makes this request, coaches will be notified.

Teams should not practice on fields (or in front of goals) that are extremely wet or have standing water. Side grass or parking lot areas should be used under these conditions.
