Select program registration fees for Girls Academy, Girls Academy ASPIRE, MLS NEXT New Tier, and USYS National League Club Premier 2 teams include the costs of applicable platform league and player registration fees, regional and/or national event registration fees, registration fees for additional tournaments and/or showcases selected by these teams' coaches, one winter indoor league and/or tournament, and coaches' travel expenses for all the above leagues, events, and/or tournaments.

Girls Academy, Girls Academy ASPIRE, MLS NEXT New Tier, and USYS National League Club Premier 2 teams will not deposit into team accounts, as the expenses typically paid from team accounts have been budgeted and included in the registration fees for players on these teams.

Personal travel expenses and uniforms will continue to be the responsibility of each player and are not included in select program registration fees. Select program uniforms are purchased on a two-year cycle and the fall 2025 season will mark the first year of a new two-year uniform cycle.



Select program registration fees for Elite (11U and 18U), Pre-Girls Academy (12U), Pre-MLS NEXT New Tier (12U), Premier and Classic teams will include the costs of registration for USYS or WYSA league play, one tournament for each outdoor season during which they play, one winter indoor league and/or tournament, and USYS Wisconsin State Championship or President's Cup (if they qualify).

Select program Elite (11U and 18U), Pre-Girls Academy (12U), Pre-MLS NEXT New Tier (12U), Premier and Classic teams will collect a \$200 deposit per player, which will be paid into a team account at the beginning of the season. The team account will be used to pay for additional tournament registration fees (beyond the included events referenced above), coaches' travel, and other incidental team-related expenses. This approach provides maximum flexibility for teams that participate in different numbers of leagues and/or tournaments, both locally and regionally. If the team account is depleted, each family will be asked to contribute a pro rata share of remaining expenses. In the event of a team account surplus at season-end, each family will be refunded a pro rata share of the remaining funds.

Personal travel expenses and uniforms will continue to be the responsibility of each player and are not included in select program registration fees. Select program uniforms are purchased on a two-year cycle and the fall 2025 season will mark the first year of a new two-year uniform cycle.

  - Champions Cup (13U-19U) – Requires qualification; March 2026 in Bradenton, FL
  - West Regional (13U-14U) – March 2026 in Oceanside, CA
  - Summer Showcase/Playoffs (13U-19U) – June 2026 in Norco, CA
  - GA Finals – Requires qualification; July 2026, location TBD

  - East Regional and Showcase (13U-19U) – April 2026 in North Carolina
- At least one regional tournament for each outdoor season during which they play
- Additional tournaments as decided by coach/Club

## Girls Academy ASPIRE (13U-19U) teams will train:

- At least 3 times per week during outdoor season(s), weather permitting
- At least 1 time per week during winter indoor season

**Club registration fees for Girls Academy ASPIRE teams/players include all the above, specifically fees for player, league and event registration, coaching, outdoor and indoor field space/time for training and matches, and coaches' travel to all team events. Club registration fees do not include personal travel expenses and uniforms, which will continue to be the responsibility of each player/family.**

  - MLS NEXT Regional (13U-19U) – April 2026 in West Chester, OH
  - MLS NEXT Cup (15U-19U) – Requires qualification; date and location TBD
- At least one regional tournament for each outdoor season during which they play
- Additional tournaments as decided by coach/Club

## MLS NEXT New Tier (13U-19U) teams will train:

- At least 3 times per week during outdoor season(s), weather permitting
- At least 1 time per week during winter indoor season

Club registration fees for MLS NEXT New Tier teams/players include all the above, specifically fees for player, league and event registration, coaching, outdoor and indoor field space/time for training and matches, and coaches' travel to all team events. Club registration fees do not include personal travel expenses and uniforms, which will continue to be the responsibility of each player/family.

- One winter indoor league/tournament
- USYS Wisconsin State Championships or Presidents Cup (if qualify)
- USYS Midwest Regional Championships or Presidents Cup Regional Championships (if qualify)
- USYS National Championships or Presidents Cup National Championships (if qualify)

## USYS National League Club Premier 2 teams will train:

- At least 3 times per week during outdoor season(s), weather permitting
- At least 1 time per week during winter indoor season

**Club registration fees for USYS National League Club Premier 2 teams/players include all the above, specifically fees for player, league and event registration, coaching, outdoor and indoor field space/time for training and matches, and coaches' travel to all team events. Club registration fees do not include personal travel expenses and uniforms, which will continue to be the responsibility of each player/family.**

Club registration fees for 11U and 18U Elite teams/players include fees for WYSA league play, Elmbrook United Select Cup, one local/regional tournament/showcase in each outdoor season during which team plays, one winter indoor league or tournament, USYS Wisconsin State Championship or President's Cup (if qualify), and training during the fall, winter and spring seasons, as applicable. Registration fees do not include additional leagues and/or tournaments or coaches' travel expenses, which are paid via an account established and funded with a \$200 per player deposit at the beginning of the fall season.

- At least one local/regional tournament in each outdoor season during which team plays
- Additional tournaments as decided by coach/Club
- One winter indoor league or tournament
- USYS Wisconsin State Championship or President's Cup (if qualify)
- Girls Academy East Regional – November 2025 in Bradenton, FL

## **12U Pre-Girls Academy teams will train:**

- 3 times per week during outdoor season(s), weather permitting
- 1 time per week during winter indoor season

**Club registration fees for 12U Pre-Girls Academy teams include fees for WYSA league play, one local/regional tournament in each outdoor season during which team plays, one winter indoor league or tournament, USYS Wisconsin State Championship or President's Cup (if qualify), Girls Academy East Regional event, and training during the fall, winter and spring seasons. Registration fees do not include additional leagues and/or tournaments or coaches' travel expenses, which are paid via an account established and funded with a \$200 per player deposit at the beginning of the fall season.**

- USYS Wisconsin State Championship or President's Cup (if qualify)
- Year-end intra-division event

## **12U Pre-MLS NEXT New Tier teams will train:**

- 3 times per week during outdoor season(s), weather permitting
- 1 time per week during winter indoor season

**Club registration fees for 12U Pre-MLS NEXT New Tier teams include fees for league play, one local/regional tournament in each outdoor season during which team plays, one winter indoor league or tournament, USYS Wisconsin State Championship or President's Cup (if qualify), the year-end intra-division event, and training during the fall, winter and spring seasons. Registration fees do not include additional leagues and/or tournaments or coaches' travel expenses, which are paid via an account established and funded with a \$200 per player deposit at the beginning of the fall season.**

## U11-U19 Premier and Classic teams may participate in:

- WYSA State League or WYSA Southeast Classic League
- Elmbrook United Select Cup
- At least one local/regional tournament/showcase in each outdoor season during which team plays
- Additional tournaments as decided by coach/Club
- One winter indoor league or tournament



## U11-19 Classic teams will train:

- 3 times per week during outdoor seasons, weather permitting
- 1 time per week during winter indoor season

Club registration fees for Classic teams/players include fees for WYSA league play, Elmbrook United Select Cup, one local/regional tournament/showcase in each outdoor season during which team plays, one winter indoor league or tournament, and training during the fall, winter and spring seasons, as applicable. Registration fees do not include additional leagues and/or tournaments or coaches' travel expenses, which are paid via an account established and funded with a \$200 per player deposit at the beginning of the fall season.



# 8<sup>th</sup> Grade Teams



## 8<sup>th</sup> grade teams may participate in:

- WYSA State League or WYSA Southeast Classic League
- Elmbrook United Select Cup (boys)
- At least one local/regional tournament/showcase
- Additional tournaments as decided by coach/Club

## 8<sup>th</sup> grade teams will train:

- 3 times per week during season, weather permitting

**The \$225 registration fee for this team will be placed in a team account and used to pay league and tournament registration fees, as well as coaches' travel expenses.**



# ADDITIONAL INFORMATION



- A one-time volunteer fee of \$150 will be charged to each family at registration. This amount will be refunded upon completion of a volunteer job for each of the family's children registered with the Club
- Referee fees are initially paid by each team, but are reimbursed by the Club
- Teams may find sponsors and/or fundraise; however, all fundraising must be approved in advance by the Elmbrook United Board of Directors
- All tryouts are conducted by the Elmbrook United coaching staff and other qualified evaluators
- According to the WYSA Tryout Policy, 11U-15U players will be notified of roster offers no earlier than noon on June 13, 2025, and 16U-19U players will be notified of roster offers no earlier than noon on June 20, 2025
- Notifications of roster offers will be communicated via PlayMetrics and email, and will continue until rosters are complete
- Players who are offered a roster spot have 24 hours to accept the offer



- If offered players do not notify the Club of their acceptance within 24 hours, their roster spots may be given to first alternate players
- Once offers are accepted, players will have until noon on Wednesday, June 18<sup>th</sup> (11U-15U) or Wednesday, June 25<sup>th</sup> (16U-19U) to register through PlayMetrics and pay the initial installment of their registration fee
- If players do not register by the dates referenced above, their offers may be rescinded and given to first alternate players at the Club's discretion
- Registration fees may be made in installments, and applications for financial aid are located on the Club's website
- Players are expected to commit to a team for the entire seasonal year (i.e., August 2025 through July 2026), and are expected to attend all team training, matches, tournaments, and events, unless excused by their coach(es)
- Players will not be excused from team activities without their coach's consent, and unexcused or frequent absences may negatively impact playing time
