Select Program 2026-2027



Select program registration fees for Girls Academy, Girls Academy ASPIRE, Girls Academy Inspire, MLS NEXT Academy, and USYS National 1 League (Premier 1 and Premier 2) teams include the costs of applicable platform league and player registration fees, regional and/or national event registration fees, registration fees for additional tournaments and/or showcases selected by these teams' coaches, one winter indoor league and/or tournament as decided on and selected by the coach, and coaches' travel expenses for all the above leagues, events, and/or tournaments.

Girls Academy, Girls Academy ASPIRE, Girls Academy Inspire, MLS NEXT Academy, and USYS National League 1 will not deposit into team accounts, as the expenses typically paid from team accounts have been budgeted and included in the registration fees for players on these teams.

Personal travel expenses and uniforms will continue to be the responsibility of each player and are not included in select program registration fees. Select program uniforms are purchased on a two-year cycle and the fall 2026 season will mark the 2nd year of a new two-year uniform cycle.



Select program registration fees for Elite, Premier, and Classic teams will include the costs of registration for league play, one tournament for each outdoor season during which they play, one winter indoor league (if decided on by coach), and/or tournament, and USYS Wisconsin State Championship or President's Cup (if decided on by coach and they qualify).

Select program Elite, Premier, and Classic teams will collect a \$200 deposit per player, which will be paid into a team account at the beginning of the season. The team account will be used to pay for additional tournament registration fees (beyond the included events referenced above), coaches' travel, and other incidental team-related expenses. This approach provides maximum flexibility for teams that participate in different numbers of leagues and/or tournaments, both locally and regionally. If the team account is depleted, each family will be asked to contribute a pro rata share of remaining expenses. In the event of a team account surplus at season-end, each family will be refunded a pro rata share of the remaining funds.

Personal travel expenses and uniforms will continue to be the responsibility of each player and are not included in select program registration fees. Select program uniforms are purchased on a two year cycle and the fall 2026 season will mark the second year of a two-year uniform cycle.

 - Winter Showcase (U15-U19) – December 2025 in Norco, CA
 - Champions Cup (U13-U19) – Requires qualification; March 2026 in Bradenton, FL
 - West Regional (U13-U14) – March 2026 in Oceanside, CA
 - Summer Showcase/Playoffs (U13-U19) – June 2026 in Norco, CA
 - GA Finals – Requires qualification; July 2026, location TBD

Girls Academy ASPIRE (U13-U19) teams will train:

- At least 3 times per week during outdoor season(s), weather permitting
- At least 1 time per week during winter indoor season

Club registration fees for Girls Academy ASPIRE teams/players include all the above, specifically fees for player, league and event registration, coaching, outdoor and indoor field space/time for training and matches, and coaches' travel to all team events. Club registration fees do not include personal travel expenses and uniforms, which will continue to be the responsibility of each player/family.

- End of season Inspire tournament

U11 and U12 Girls Academy Inspire teams will train:

- 3 times per week during outdoor season(s), weather permitting
- 1 time per week during winter indoor season

Club registration fees for U11 and U12 Girls Academy Inspire teams include fees for league play, one local/regional tournament in each outdoor season during which team plays, one winter indoor league or tournament if decided on by coach, USYS Wisconsin State Championship or President's Cup (if qualify), Girls Inspire events, and training during the fall, winter and spring seasons.





MLS NEXT Academy (U13-U19) teams may participate in:

- MLS Next Academy league
 - Approximately 18 league games (half home/half away)
 - Travel primarily in Midwest region
- MLS NEXT events and showcases
 - MLS NEXT Fest (U13-U19) – December 2026 at TBD location on West Coast
 - MLS NEXT Regional (U13-U19) – Spring 2027 - Kansas City
 - MLS NEXT Cup (U15-U19) – Requires qualification; date and location TBD
- At least one regional tournament for each outdoor season during which they play
- Additional tournaments as decided by coach/Club





MLS NEXT Academy (U13-U19) teams will train:

- At least 3 times per week during outdoor season(s), weather permitting
- At least 1 time per week during winter indoor season

Club registration fees for MLS NEXT Academy teams/players include all the above, specifically fees for player, league and event registration, coaching, outdoor and indoor field space/time for training and matches, and coaches' travel to all team events. Club registration fees do not include personal travel expenses and uniforms, which will continue to be the responsibility of each player/family.

- Year-end intra-division event

U12 Pre-MLS NEXT Academy Division teams will train:

- 3 times per week during outdoor season(s), weather permitting
- 1 time per week during winter indoor season

Club registration fees for U12 Pre-MLS NEXT Academy teams include fees for league play, one local/regional tournament in each outdoor season during which team plays, one winter indoor league or tournament if decided by coach, USYS Wisconsin State Championship or President's Cup (if qualified), the year-end event if applicable, and training during the fall, winter and spring seasons.





USYS National League 1 (Premier 1 and Premier 2) teams may participate in:

- National League 1 (Premier 1 and Premier 2) League
 - Approximately 12-16 league matches
 - Travel primarily within Wisconsin and Illinois
- National League 1 regional and national tournaments if qualified
- At least one regional tournament for each outdoor season during which they play
- Additional tournaments as decided by coach/Club
- One winter indoor league/tournament
- USYS Wisconsin State Championships or Presidents Cup (if qualify)
- USYS Midwest Regional Championships or Presidents Cup Regional Championships (if qualify)\
- USYS National Championships or Presidents Cup National Championships (if qualify)

- At least 3 times per week during outdoor season(s), weather permitting
- At least 1 time per week during winter indoor season

Club registration fees for USYS National League (Premier 1 and Premier 2) teams/players include all the above, specifically fees for player, league and event registration, coaching, outdoor and indoor field space/ time for training and matches, and coaches' travel to all team events. Club registration fees do not include personal travel expenses and uniforms, which will continue to be the responsibility of each player/family.



U11 and U12 ELITE



U11 and U12 Elite teams may participate in:

- WYSA State League or WYSA Southeast Classic League
- Elmbrook United Select Cup
- At least one local/regional tournament/showcase in each outdoor season during which team plays
- Additional tournaments as decided by coach/Club
- One winter indoor league or tournament
- USYS Wisconsin State Championship or President's Cup

U11 and U12 Elite teams will train:

- 3 times per week during outdoor seasons, weather permitting
- 1 time per week during winter indoor season

Club registration fees for U11 and U12 Elite teams/players include fees for WYSA league play, Elmbrook United Select Cup, one local/regional tournament/showcase in each outdoor season during which team plays, one winter indoor league or tournament, USYS Wisconsin State Championship or President's Cup (if qualify), and training during the fall, winter and spring seasons, as applicable. Registration fees do not include additional leagues and/or tournaments or coaches' travel expenses, which are paid via an account established and funded with a \$200 per player deposit at the beginning of the fall season.



PREMIER and CLASSIC



U11-U19 Premier and Classic teams may participate in:

- WYSA State League or WYSA Southeast Classic League
- Elmbrook United Select Cup
- At least one local/regional tournament/showcase in each outdoor season during which team plays
- Additional tournaments as decided by coach/Club
- One winter indoor league or tournament

U11-19 Premier and Classic teams will train:

- 3 times per week during outdoor seasons, weather permitting
- 1 time per week during winter indoor season

Club registration fees for Classic teams/players include fees for WYSA league play, Elmbrook United Select Cup, one local/regional tournament/showcase in each outdoor season during which team plays, one winter indoor league or tournament, and training during the fall, winter and spring seasons, as applicable. Registration fees do not include additional leagues and/or tournaments or coaches' travel expenses, which are paid via an account established and funded with a \$200 per player deposit at the beginning of the fall season.



ADDITIONAL INFORMATION



- A one-time volunteer fee of \$150 will be charged to each family at registration. This amount will be refunded upon completion of a volunteer job for each of the family's children registered with the Club
- Referee fees are initially paid by each team, but are reimbursed by the Club
- Teams may find sponsors and/or fundraise; however, all fundraising must be approved in advance by the Elmbrook United Board of Directors
- Notifications of roster offers will be communicated via PlayMetrics and email. They will continue until rosters are complete
- Players who are offered a roster spot have 24 hours to accept the offer
